## DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ANY OR ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

#### **Old Business:**

A. Ordinance 16-004: An ordinance amending Chapter 100 to eliminate certain committees and authorities from Mayoral Appointments.

**Rusch** explained this item was tabled at last week's meeting as the committee felt the Mayor should be present for the discussion. There was a brief discussion as it was understood where the Mayor was coming from with wanting to eliminate some of the committees, but questioned even though committees do not meet on a regular basis, what is the harm in keeping them on the books.

Mayor commented that he and the City Administrator had discussed the elimination of certain committees. This topic was brought up at a League of Municipalities Conference where it was said there is no need for a committee when the majority of the members are part of the Council. Mayor went on to explain his reasons for wanting to eliminate the committees listed in Ordinance 16-004. The Citizens' Solid Waste Committee has only met 5 times in its existence with the last meeting being in 2005; the Community Development Authority has not met in the past 6 years; the Joint City/School Park & Rec Committee met mainly to discuss the lease agreement at Memorial Field which the school no longer leases and we still have a Park & Rec Committee in place; all of the members on the Ordinance Committee are Council members and the Ordinance Meetings have been few and very short throughout the past years; the Main Street Rehabilitation Committee has only

met 2 times in its existence with the last meeting being in 2008; the Safety Committee has not met in the past 14 years; and the Street, Public Property & Public Works Committee meetings have been few and very short throughout the past 5 years.

**Rusch** agreed with the elimination of some committees but would like to see the Ordinance Committee remain on the books. Coopman also mentioned at last week's meeting that he would like to see the Ordinance Committee remain intact.

**McDermid** also agreed with keeping the Ordinance Committee.

**City Administrator** reiterated the suggestion from the League of Municipalities Conference with regards to cleaning up the list of committees. It was also mentioned at the conference that even if you have a committee in place, you can bring an item right to Council and not go through the committee.

**City Attorney** confirmed the matter of policy in which you can bring an item to a committee or directly to Council.

**Osborne** suggested an alternative in which there could be a Committee of a Whole. With this committee, you can discuss anything. He also mentioned that the Ordinance/Code Book was in need of being updated.
