Height:	50-60 Feet
Width:	30-40 Feet
Shape:	Vase shaped
Foliage:	Small green leaves start to appear in the spring. These glossy leaves feature tooth-margins and asymmetrical bases.
Flowers:	N/A
Fruit:	Wafer-like samaras by late April.
Description:	Triumph™ Elm is one of the best modern Elms available. It features a spectacular upright-oval form that develops early, and matures into that instantly-recognizable vase-shape.
Fall Color:	During the fall, the dark green leaves transform into a burnished golden yellow hue.
Advantages:	You will want to add this tree to your landscape for its color and hardiness. The Triumph elm is prized for its resistance to Dutch elm disease, elm yellows, and the elm leaf beetle.
Site & Culture:	Grow in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in full sun. Tolerant of light shade. Prefers rich, moist loams. Adapts to both wet and dry sites. Generally tolerant of urban conditions. Regular pruning and spraying is advisable.
