NOTICE OF REFERENDUM ELECTION  
OCONTO FALLS PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT

TAKE NOTICE that a referendum election shall be held on November 8, 2022 in the Oconto Falls Public School District for the purpose of approving or rejecting an Initial Resolution adopted by the School Board of said District on August 22, 2022.

The Initial Resolution reads as follows:

INITIAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING  
GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS  
IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED  
\$37,630,000

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the Oconto Falls Public School District, Oconto County, Wisconsin, that there shall be issued, pursuant to Chapter 67, Wisconsin Statutes, General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$37,630,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing a new middle school; removal of the existing middle school; improvements to the elementary and high school buildings and grounds including secure entrances and roof replacements/repairs; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.

The referendum ballot will ask District electors: "Shall the foregoing resolution of the School Board of the Oconto Falls Public School District be approved?"

A "yes" vote is in favor of the Initial Resolution set forth above and is a vote to approve the borrowing of not to exceed \$37,630,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing a new middle school; removal of the existing middle school; improvements to the elementary and high school buildings and grounds including secure entrances and roof replacements/repairs; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.

A "no" vote is opposed to the Initial Resolution and is a vote to deny the Oconto Falls Public School District the authority to borrow not to exceed \$37,630,000 for the purpose of paying the cost of constructing a new middle school; removal of the existing middle school; improvements to the elementary and high school buildings and grounds including secure entrances and roof replacements/repairs; and equipment acquisition related to said projects.
