

**18. 2025 WI DNR Urban Forestry Plan**

Eocene Environmental group and WI DNR did the tree inventory and urban forestry operations plan was conducted during the summer of 2025. The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Urban Forestry & Community Forestry (U&CF) Program provided funding to complete a GIS-based-computerized tree inventory. Trees growing in maintained public locations (e.g., street trees, parks, and other public green spaces) were inventoried. In brief, this involved collecting tree and site information, which was then assessed for tree management needs. The identified actions were then compiled into an operations plan for proposed tree actions over a five-year period. Eocene Environmental Group was contracted to complete the inventory and operations plan for the City of Oconto

Falls. This includes but is not limited to recommended field maintenance operations over a five-year time duration. Trees requiring pruning or removal were identified as primary and secondary maintenance operations for each individual inventoried tree throughout the community. A total of 1145 trees were inventoried. By location there were 859 trees along streets, 263 trees within parks, and 22 on facilities. Public safety is important and as such trees were identified for tree removal based on potential risk from dead trees, those with unacceptable structural weakness, or those likely to die in the immediate future. A total of 146 trees were identified for removal and these were prioritized for removal as either a priority 1 (46 trees) to remove first, and then remove trees identified as priority 2 (100 trees). Trees that require pruning for public safety (e.g., dead branches > 2 inches, clearance issues) or to benefit tree stability (e.g., pruning for branching structure) were identified and prioritized. A total 209 trees were identified. These were also ranked according to priority 1 or 2 status. Small trees were also identified for structural tree pruning which would benefit their future stability and resistance to damage from storms. Planting sites along streets, in terrace areas, and parks were individually identified. An estimated 2,605 trees could be planted along streets and within parks. This potential could be considered for a full-stocking goal for the community at the present level of development. A total of 73 trees are identified as ash trees (green and white). Nearly all showed signs of EAB and removal is noted as a priority 1 or 2 as presented above. Ideally, the tree population should be comprised of not more than 5% of any one species, 10% of any one genus, and 20% within a plant family. This is important to minimize the risk of an aggressive pest of decimating a tree population. Currently 5 tree species exceed the species threshold and these account for 53.8 percent of the total tree population. These species are: Norway maple (15.5%), silver maple (8.7%), honeylocust (6.6%), red pine (6.5%), Eastern white pine (5.9%), white spruce (5.5%), and Northern white cedar (5.2%). Specific details on tree diversity are presented in the plan. The total estimated replacement value of all trees inventoried is \$3,794,302 or a mean \$3,314 per tree estimate. This was determined by using the Council of Tree and Landscape Appraisers Guide for Plant Appraisal (10th Edition) to determine valuation. An annual \$45,327 estimated cost is proposed to implement immediate management needs and to develop a proposed longer-term set of management priorities.

September Update

**Street Department** is finalizing painting parking lots and parks in the City.

**Assessment update:** Board of Review is being held Thursday September 4<sup>th</sup> 5 to 7pm. The Board of Review is hearing challenges to Property assessments and accepting 2025 Property assessment roll for the City.

**TID#3-Annual Joint Review Board Meeting**, Friday 5<sup>th</sup> 12:00pm. Reviewing 2024 Annual Report with the Board members and Citizen Representative.

**Annexation of County I** -The Annexation packet and Ordinance has been filed with Wisconsin Department of Administration (WI DOA). The WI DOA will then send the Annexation packet to the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WI DOT), for their review. Following approval, the WI DOT will notify the Oconto County Highway Commissioner, Brandon Hytinen, who will schedule a Highway Safety Committee meeting to review transferring ownership to the City and make a recommendation to the full Oconto County Board.

**County I Speed limit change:** Chief Brad Olsen and Sheriff Todd Skarban have contacted the Oconto County Highway Commissioner Brandon Hytinen regarding options to change the speed on County I and the School zone speed before all the above process items are complete. There is an Oconto county Highway Safety Committee meeting next week, on the agenda is a speed study for the portion of County I in front of the schools. The County is seeking to have the city share in a portion of the study; the City's portion is expected to be \$2k. It is expected to be conducted the week of Sept 8<sup>th</sup>, upon results of the study, the WI Dept of Transportation could approve a speed change down to 35 mph in that area.

**Columbia Street Project Update:** The first layer of asphalt on Columbia Street was being completed Thursday August 28<sup>th</sup>. Friday August 29<sup>th</sup> the second layer was applied, and driveway approaches were paved as well. The street will be open to traffic on Tuesday for school traffic and buses, although some of the barricades on side streets may remain, while painting and finishing items are completed. The street may close periodically during the day to complete pavement painting and finish details.

**Thursday September 4<sup>th</sup>** I will be meeting with Mediation with our City Attorney and the Claimants attorney for the Gallas Road Driveway, from 8:30am to 3:00pm at Amundsen Davis Law Firm office in Green Bay.

**Territory Agreement** discussion with the Utility Commission's attorney on Tuesday, we are seeking to complete an agreement to recommend to Utility Commission and City Council to approve and then present.

**Developer Meeting** on Tuesday to review potential development and potential infrastructure needed to create a development, will review expected development costs.

**Planning Commission will be held on Tuesday September 9<sup>th</sup> 5:30pm** prior to the City Council meeting. This is a public hearing for Amending the City's 2008 Comprehensive Plan Map, to change the proposed project area from proposed Industrial use to Residential. At Council there will be an Ordinance adoption of the Amendment to the 2008 comprehensive Plan.

**2026 Budget**-Preliminary Department Budget discussions, and planned 2026 Capital Purchases will be starting, while waiting for updated equalized values from the State to determine the City's levy.

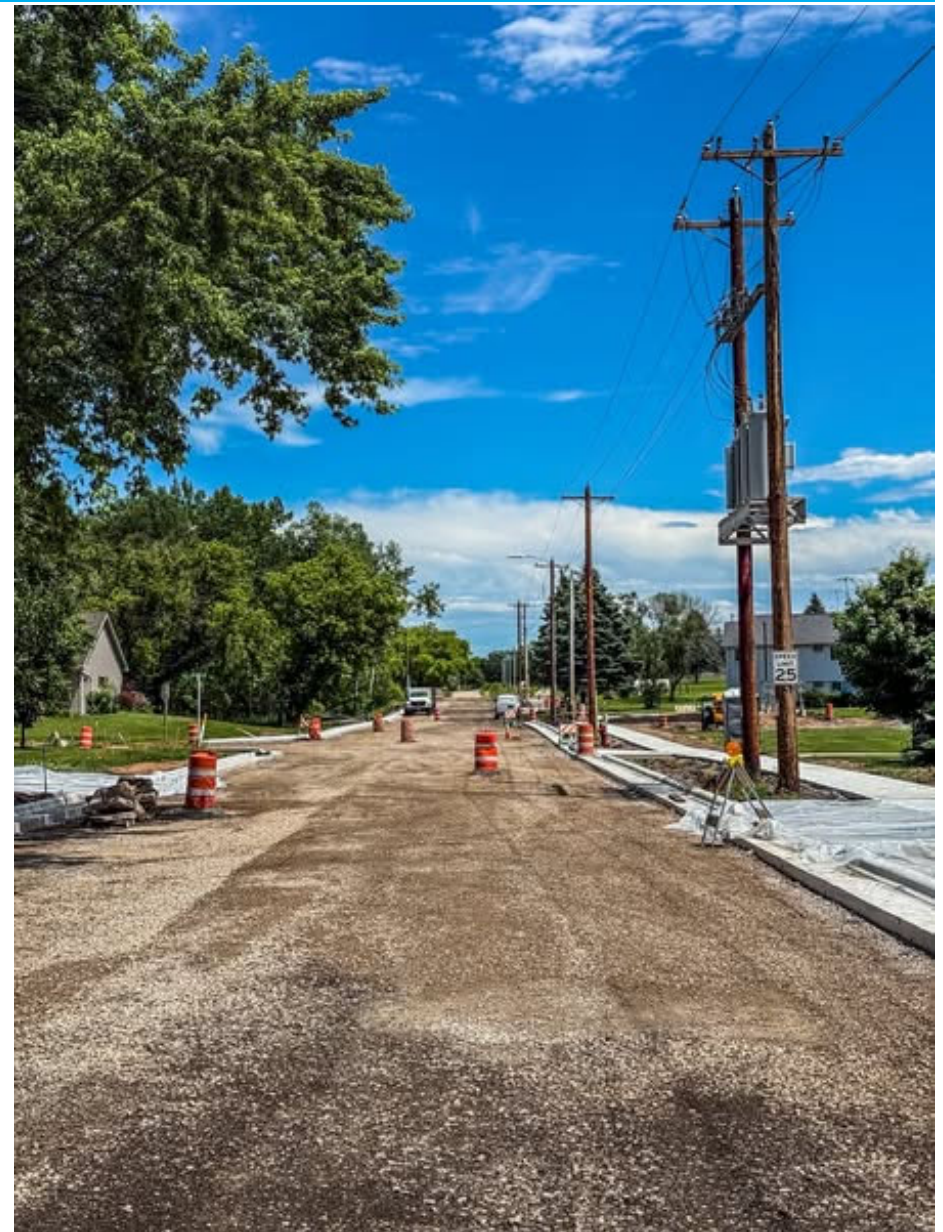

To Appeal Assessment

#### OPEN BOOK

STEP 1

Notices are sent to property owners when a new value is set by the assessor.

Property owners can discuss their value with the assessor during the Open Book period.

#### BOARD OF REVIEW

STEP 2

Court-like setting in front of municipal officials.

The value of the assessor is deemed correct.

Property owners must provide evidence to the board to prove the assessor's value incorrect.

#### APPEAL AFTER BOARD OF REVIEW 70.85

STEP 3

After the Board of Review the objector can file an appeal to the state under statute 70.85.

This appeal must be submitted within 20 days of the Board of Review's determination.

#### DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE HEARING

STEP 4

If certain requirements are met the Department of Revenue will set a hearing.

The objector and the assessor cannot bring new evidence.

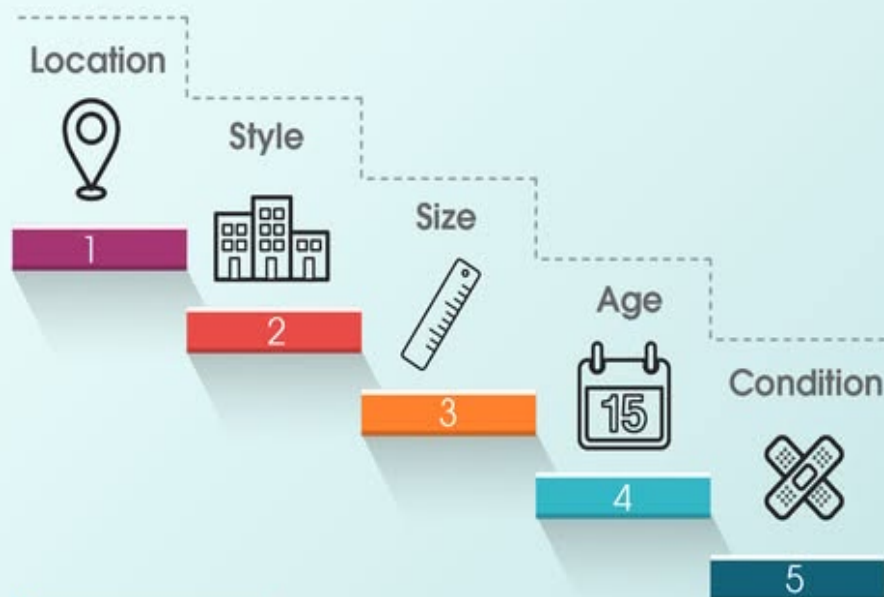

With 39,131 residents, Oconto County is the 38th most populous county in Wisconsin. It also ranks as the 25th fastest-growing county in the state. Since the 2020 Census, the county's population has increased by 166 residents. Growth was largely concentrated in two towns: Little Suamico and Chase. These are the two southernmost municipalities in the county, both of which are adjacent to Brown County.

## Aging Population

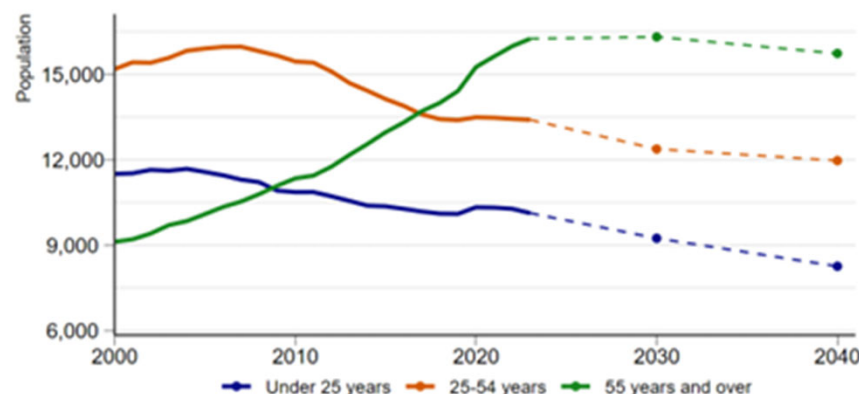


Figure 11: US Census Bureau, Population Estimates Program and WI Department of Administration, Demographic Services Center.

The changing age structure of Oconto County's population has several implications, including a declining contribution of natural increase to overall population growth and a long-term workforce quantity challenge. These shifts are shown more explicitly here.

The most visible manifestation of these changes is the growth in the number of residents who are at least 55 years old. This age group increased from 9,117 in 2000 to 16,250 in 2023. In percentage terms, its share of the total population rose from 25.5% in 2000 to 40.9% in 2023.

Meanwhile, the number of residents in the 25–54 age range declined from 15,185 in 2000 to 13,402 in 2023. This group accounted for 33.7% of the county's total population in 2023, down from 42.4% in 2000. The population under age 25 followed a similar pattern, decreasing from 11,502 in 2000 to 10,123 in 2023, with its share of the total population falling from 32.1% to 25.5%.

While the projected population changes continue the trends for the two younger age groups, a projected decline in the 55 and over group represents a newer development. Between 2023 and 2040, the under 25 and 25–54 age groups are expected to decrease by 1,868 and 1,432 people, respectively. The projected decline in the 55 and over group is more modest, at 515 people.

These age groups are significant because they correspond to different stages of typical labor force participation. Participation rises sharply beginning at ages 16 to 24, although residents in this group are less likely to work full-time due to enrollment in secondary or postsecondary education. Those aged 25 to 54 are considered in their prime working years. Participation begins to decline sharply at age 55, as individuals approach retirement or exit the labor force entirely.

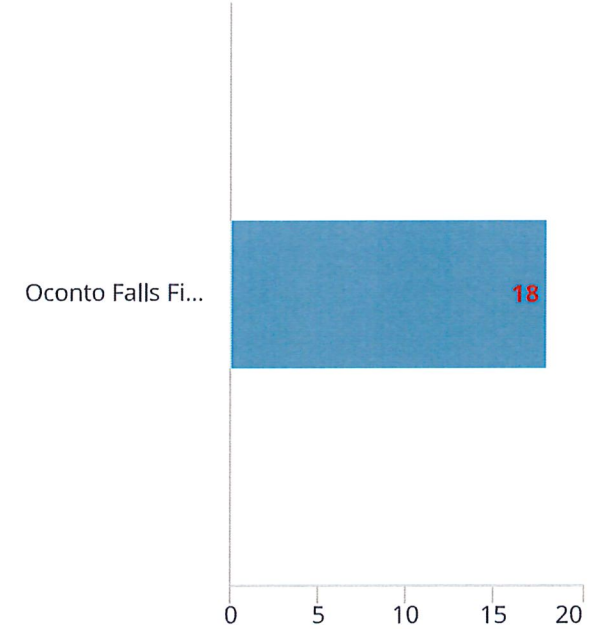

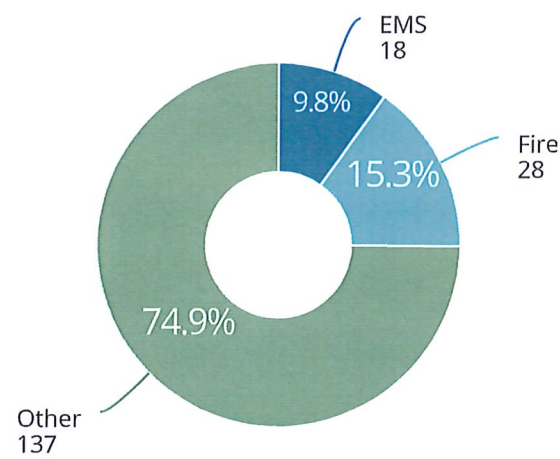

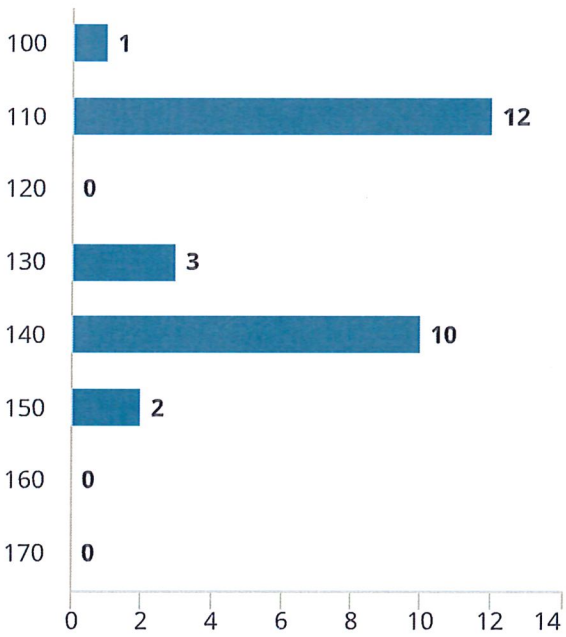
EMS/Fire Incident Breakdown



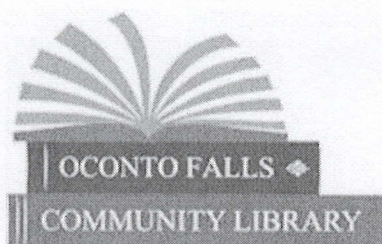

## **Grants and Advocacy**

- City's Innovation Planning Grant w/ Jess Wildes, Jay Shambeau (consultants): no updates as of 9/2/25
- Wisconsin received the rest of its Grants to States funding. This again provides some short-term stability, but the federal budget passed in July only delegates \$6 million to close down the Institute of Museum and Library Services.
- Perhaps legislators will take other action to fund the IMLS in future as the details of the Federal budget are hammered out. Anyone who would like can still make their concerns known to their federal representatives (Representative Tony Wied, Senator Ron Johnson, Senator Tammy Baldwin)

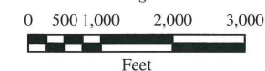

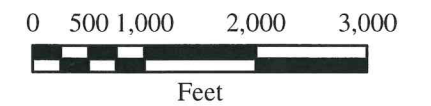
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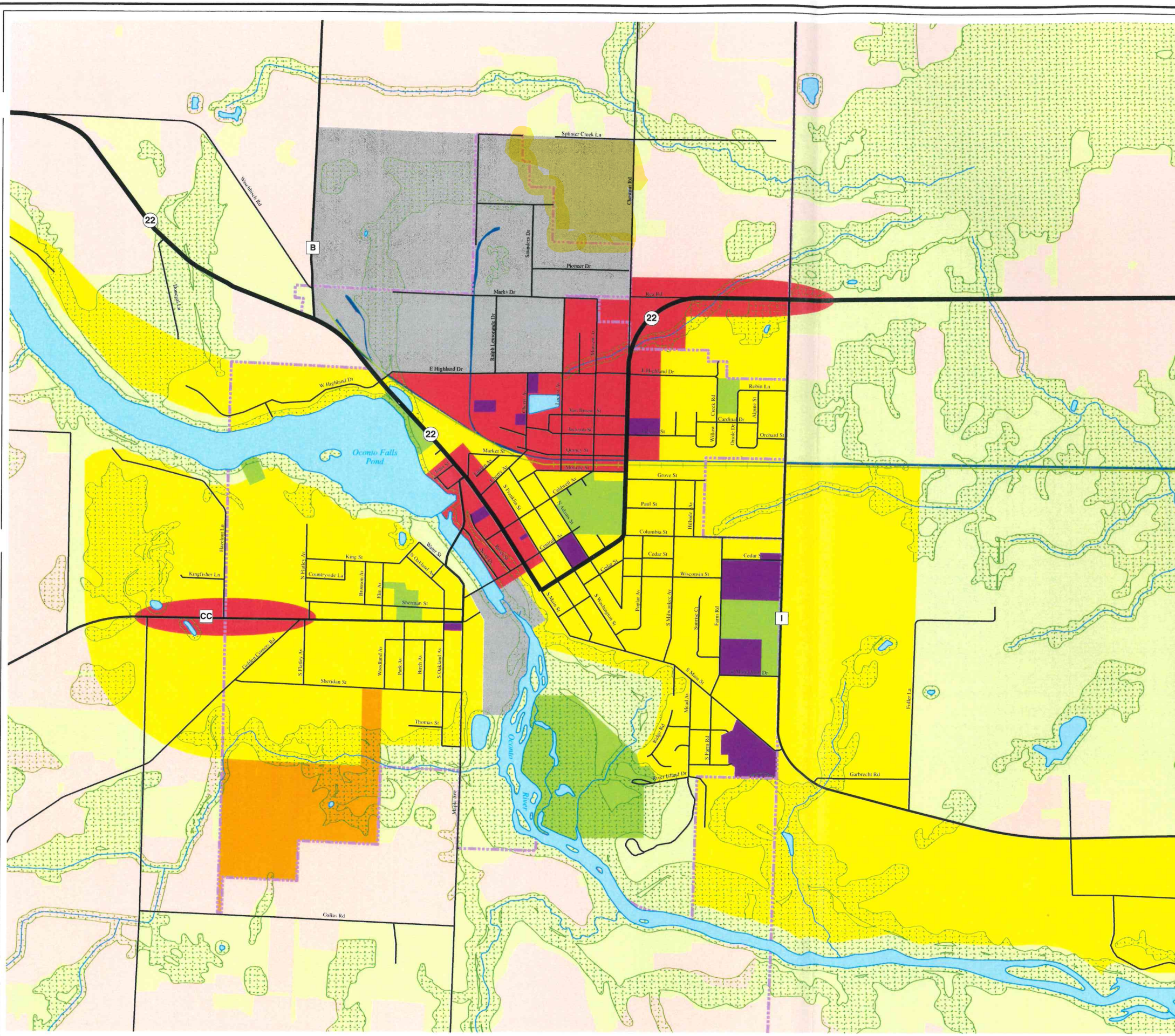

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-008**

An Ordinance to Adopt an Amendment to The City of Oconto Falls 2008 Comprehensive Plan  
Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 66.1001

WHEREAS, the City of Oconto Falls contains a 2008 Comprehensive Plan for the City of Oconto Falls under the guidelines of Section 66.1001 Wisconsin Statutes; and,

WHEREAS, the plan included a public participation plan for gathering public input during the preparation of the *City of Oconto Falls 20-Year Comprehensive Plan* Amendment One, which addressed provisions for the required distribution of the proposed elements of the comprehensive plan and provided an opportunity for written comments to be submitted by the public and for the city to respond to such comments; and,

WHEREAS, the Oconto Falls Plan Commission held a public hearing on September 9, 2025, which was preceded by a Class 1 Notice as described in Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 985 that was published at least 30 days before the hearing was held and included all of the following information:

1. The date, time and location of the hearing;
2. A summary of the proposed comprehensive plan;
3. The name of the individual employed by Oconto Falls who may provide additional information regarding the proposed ordinance;
4. Information relating to where and when the proposed comprehensive plan could be inspected before the hearing and how a copy of the plan could be obtained; and,

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2025, the Oconto Falls Plan Commission recommended to the Oconto Falls Common Council adoption of the *City of Oconto Falls 20-Year Comprehensive Plan* Amendment One by resolution with that vote recorded in the official minutes of the Plan Commission; and,

WHEREAS, the Oconto Falls Common Council, having carefully reviewed the recommendation of the Oconto Falls Plan Commission, having determined that all procedural requirements and notice have been satisfied, having given the matter due consideration, including consideration of the plan elements relating to issues and opportunities, natural, agricultural and cultural resources, population and housing, economic development, transportation, utilities and community facilities, intergovernmental cooperation, land use and implementation, and having determined that the comprehensive plan amendment will serve the general purposes of guiding and accomplishing a coordinated, adjusted and harmonious development of Oconto Falls, which will in accordance with existing and future needs, best promote the public health, safety, morals, order, convenience, prosperity and the general welfare, as well as efficiency and economy in the process of development.



NOW, THEREFORE, the Oconto Falls Common Council, Oconto County, Wisconsin,  
DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The comprehensive plan amendment recommended by the Oconto Falls Plan Commission to the Oconto Falls Common Council, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted.

Section 2: The City Clerk is directed to file a copy of the attached comprehensive plan for the City of Oconto Falls with all the following entities:

1. The Clerk of every local governmental unit that is adjacent to Oconto Falls;
2. The Wisconsin Department of Administration;
3. The Bay-Lake Regional Planning Commission; and
4. The public library that serves Oconto Falls.

Section 3: SEVERABILITY. Several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, such decision shall only apply to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision, and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms in conflict.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance will take effect immediately upon passage as provided by law

Adopted this 9th day of September 2025, by a majority vote of the members of the Oconto Falls Common Council.
