Aaron Trempe spoke of concerns with the speed limit being high on County I and needing to be lowered but proceeding with the annexation to lower the speed limit will create an island of two properties one of these properties being his. The cities only option for the speed limit to be lowered at the time was to do the annexation and City Administrator Wills and Police Chief Olsen have been working together with the state and county to get it lowered with no success. So the annexation was the only option. Police Chief Olsen explained that he has been on the Traffic Safety Commission for twelve years and has tried to get the speed limit lowered for about ten years with no success. The state did do an engineering study in the past ten years and it did not give enough evidence that the speed limit at that time needed to be lowered. In order for the speed limit to be lowered there needs to be eighty five percent of the traffic to go the speed limit or lower. There is a speed study going to be happening the week of September 8,2025.

City Administrator Wills has reached out to the Department of Administration about this creating an island. They were made aware and note that this is not one of the reasons they stop an annexation. If speed study is completed and the study shows the speed limit can be lowered through the county and state then the annexation might not have to go through.
